With the proliferation in technology comes an increased ability to collect, share, and manage data. This workshop will focus on using iNaturalist and Calflora apps, as well as tips for taking photos to aid in later identification or photomonitoring. We will also cover technology-based tools for plant ID. We will spend the morning in the classroom, then use our gadgets in the field after lunch, returning to the classroom to go over data upload and editing. Some experience or comfort with technology is preferred but not essential; we will focus on basic, broadly useful tools but this is not meant to be an introductory course.

Morning coffee and snacks along with a bag lunch are included.
